Thank you for requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Request

I am currently working on my MSc degree, and I am writing a critical analysis on a PSIRF/RCA report that has been done in the last 12 months. Would it be possible to be given access to one redacted PSIRF reports from theatre within the last 12 months for educational purposes.

Response

The Trust does hold this information; however, the reports contain very detailed and highly sensitive personal information which the Trust believes that even if some of the information is redacted (blacked out), then the nature and information relating to the incident would still identify the individual (data subject). We are therefore withholding this information under section 40 of the Freedom of Information Act.

The Trust is also applying section 41 of the Freedom of Information Act; the disclosure of the information to the public (otherwise than under this Act) by the public authority holding it would constitute a breach of confidence actionable by that or any other person.

If you are dissatisfied with our response, you have the right to appeal in line with guidance from the Information Commissioner. In the first instance you may contact the Information Governance Manager of the Trust.
