Thank you for requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Request

I am analysing the treatment of lung cancer and would greatly appreciate if you could answer the following question:

Q1. How many non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC) patients were treated in the past 3 months with:

- ALK Inhibitors (Alectinib, Brigatinib, Ceritinib, Crizotinib, Lorlatinib)
- Amivantamab
- Atezolizumab Monotherapy
- Atezolizumab + Bevacizumab + Carboplatin + Paclitaxel
- Dabrafenib + Trametinib
- Docetaxel monotherapy or in combination with Carboplatin/Cisplatin
- Durvalumab
- Gemcitabine
- Nitedanib + Docetaxel
- Nivolumab
- Osimertinib
- Other EGFR Inhibitors (Afatinib, Erlotinib, Gefitinib, Dacomitinib, Mobocertinib)
- Paclitaxel
- Pembrolizumab Monotherapy
- Pembrolizumab + Paclitaxel + Platinum (Carboplatin/Cisplatin)
- Pembrolizumab + Pemetrexed + Platinum (Carboplatin/Cisplatin)
- Pemetrexed + Platinum (Carboplatin/Cisplatin)
- RET Inhibitors (Pralsetinib, Selpercatinib)
- Sotorasib
- Tepotinib
- Vinorelbine monotherapy or in combination with Carboplatin/Cisplatin
- Other active systemic anti-cancer therapy
- Palliative care only

Response

To provide the information you have requested the Trust would need to look at individual patient records which is exempt under section 40 of the Act, Personal Information. The Trust is also applying Section 12(1) of the Act as the cost of compliance would exceed the appropriate limit.

The Trust does not hold this data centrally, to determine this would require a manual trawl of each individual reports relating patient records, therefore the Trust is unable to provide all of the information requested as this would exceed the time and cost limits, as set out in the Act. The Trust is therefore applying Section 12 of the Act (where cost of compliance exceeds appropriate limit
