Caring for a loved one with dementia offers rewards as well as challenges. It is important to remember that the person you love is still there, and accepting that change is inevitable will help you move forward. No one needs to cope with dementia alone; support for carers is a vital link to the well-being of dementia sufferers.

Supporting our Dementia Appeal

A relaxed care environment can increase the well-being of our patients with dementia. Therefore we are developing specially designed spaces where patients can reminisce, and staff can take time out to respond to their reality.

We understand that providing the right environment alongside meaningful activities makes a difference in enhancing patients' experience. The care offered within our elderly care ward includes patients accessing a day room and staff facilitating group sessions.

The charity has funded specialist reminiscence therapy computers. The software is patient-led for individual circumstances and needs. We have the ability to create someone's life story to include photographs, film clips, music, etc. We can document a patient's favourite films and artists; we can even record a family member

speaking (which may calm their distressed relative when they are not able to be there in person). The addition of these to the wards has been invaluable.

It is important to remember that not only is a diagnosis of dementia difficult for the person with the disease; it also poses significant challenges for those who take care of the patient. We liaise with caregivers to ensure they receive all the information and support they need.
